

**2024 - 2025 SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST**  
**Alliance Charter Elementary - Neenah, WI**

**4K:**

- 1 backpack large enough to hold a school folder 14" x 18"
- 2 large boxes of tissues
- 2 **bottom** pocket folders (**please label**)
- 1 bottle of Elmer's white liquid glue
- \$5 for headphones pre-purchased for the classroom
- Scotch brand thermal laminating pouches, clear, 3 mil. fits letter sized (8.9 in. x 11.4 in.) paper, 25 or 50 count pack
- 1 ream of white card stock
- A complete change of clothing, all items labeled individually with names (underwear, pants, T-shirt, socks).

**Kindergarten:**

- 1 backpack large enough to hold school work (14" x 18" folders)  

**Please label the backpack with the child's name**
- Small beach towel - plain, with no characters, please
- 1 box of gallon-size Ziploc bags last names A - J
- 1 box of sandwich-size Ziploc bags last names K - Z
- 2 large boxes of Kleenex tissues
- 2 boxes of 12-count colored pencils (Crayola preferred, classic colors)
- 24 #2 wooden pencils (sharpened, Ticonderoga preferred)
- 1 Fiskar scissors (**please label**)
- 6 glue sticks
- 2 boxes of 24-count crayons (Crayola preferred, classic colors)
- 1 box of thick markers (Crayola preferred, classic colors)
- 2 **bottom** pocket folders (**please label**)
- 1 pair of gym shoes (**please label**)
- 4 pink pearl erasers
- 1 large container of disinfectant wipes (not baby wipes - Clorox preferred)
- Change of clothes to keep in the backpack
- 1 pair of headphones (**please label**, no earbuds, no wireless, straight jacks only - no "L-shaped" jacks)

## Grades 1-2-3

- 2nd pair of shoes ideally for gym (labeled, to stay indoors at school, tie shoes if possible and practice before school begins)
- 1 backpack large enough to hold school work (20L not to exceed 30L) [Link of example](#)

- 1 pair of croc-like indoor/outdoor slip-on shoes.  
**(Bardosy only)**
- 1 wooden clipboard with metal clip (can use from last year, labeled)
- 1 reasonably sized set of headphones- no earbuds, no wireless, straight jacks only, **no volume control on the cord**) [link of an example](#)
- [Standard size pencil box](#) (5x8) **LABELED** please fill with the following
  - Scissors (reuse if you have them)
- No spill water bottle **LABELED** (should go back and forth to home)

No pencil sharpeners, they will be provided as needed

- 1 package of colored pencils
- 2 pearl or white erasers or package of cap erasers
- 1 package of Sharpies or dry erase markers
- 1 glue bottle
- 2 packages of 3x3 Post-it notes
- 2 package of markers
- 1 pair of scissors (labeled) can use from last year
- 1 clipboard (labeled) can use from last year
- 1 standard-sized pencil box (labeled) can use from last year
- 1 pair of wired headphones (labeled)
- 2 boxes of kleenex
