

Student fees for the 2024-25 school year were approved by the Neenah Joint School District Board of Education at its June 4 meeting.

Several of the fees have not been updated in several years, but no changes were made to the fees for the upcoming school year.

New hires approved include Samantha Fieck as a social worker at Taft, teachers Matthew Dahms and Courtney Sievert at the high school and Angela Townsend-Ewald as a fifth grade teacher at the middle school. Resignations were approved for Lakeview and Clayton literacy interventionist Megan Ruffing, Horace Mann sign language interpreter Rebecca Kelly, Horace Mann behavioral interventionist Amanda Rebman and Director of Pupil Services Stephanie Phernetton.

A bid for a remodeling project for the special education area at Tullar was presented. The selected bid for Frank Zeise construction came in at \$177,000, which was well below the budgeted amount of \$250,000. The project includes adding an ADA restroom, a washing machine and dryer, while renovating two special education classrooms and a common space.

The Board also honored freshman Celia Gentile for her state runner-up finish in the long jump at the state track and field meet. She also went to state this year in team tennis and girls basketball.
